Sorry to trouble you again, but i am hoping for an indication of the possible accuracy of the assertions i've made. And, dependent on that answer, what my status could be as a commission witness and what support might be available.

I am speculating that i could be a 'star witness', and residing longterm in a witness trailer in Camp Justice (secure & cared for) sounds lovely to me at the moment - June feels like an eternity away for me, specifically because of the emotional burden i'm carrying, complicating factors and my daily struggles.

Arrival in Taiz recollection:

My arrival in Taiz: the Sanaa to Taiz taxi driver & his mate (translator) only had the address i gave them, the PO Box 5302 and the mis-spelt company name. I recall we stopped on the outskirts of Taiz to ask directions and that we were told "that'll be the foreigners compound" (i guess deducted by the Taiz resident because of my nationality/caucasian appearance). I assume from this that there were a significant number of foreigners visiting the PO Box 5302 location in Taiz.
